The transnational meeting of the RE-BUILT ERASMUS + KA2 - HIGHER EDUCATION STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS program took place in Cassino from Sunday 18 to Tuesday 20 July 2021.

The meeting was attended by prof. Ancuța ROTARU of the Technical University "Gheorghe Asachi" - Iași, prof. Wei WU and Jingxiu WANG of the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences Gregor Mendel Strasse - Vienna, prof. Chavdar KOLEV from Todor Kableshkov Higher School of Transport - Sofia, Kaja POGAČAR from University of Maribor.

The meeting, in line with the aims of the project, was characterized on the one hand by the process of disseminating knowledge of the cultural heritage of the city of Cassino and its surroundings, including the main local gastronomic attractions; on the other hand it was a very important moment of discussion between all the participants on the performance of the subsequent activities related to the project.

In detail, on Sunday morning the Historiale, multimedia museum was visited. The Historiale Museum created for the sixtieth anniversary of the battle of Montecassino to honor the fallen of all nations who lost their lives for peace and freedom. The exhibition, conceived by Officine Rambaldi, creates an emotional journey, which transforms the visit to the museum into a dive into history, especially the events of the Second World War. In the afternoon, starting at 2 pm, the group of participants went to Montecassino to visit the prestigious Benedictine abbey which is one of the oldest monasteries in Italy. It rises 516 meters above sea level and was founded in 529 by San Benedetto da Norcia on the site of an ancient tower and a temple dedicated to Apollo. Throughout its history, the Abbey has experienced an alternation of destruction, looting, earthquakes and subsequent reconstructions. The latest destruction dates to the bombing of the IIWW. Historical testimonies of the highest interest and of certain validity have been collected and handed down in Montecassino: from the first precious documents in the vernacular to the famous Cassinese illuminated manuscripts, to the precious and very rare incunabula. The participants also visited the Archive with the help of Don Mariano. The first parchment in Italian: "*Sao ko kelle terre, per kelle fini que ki contene trenta anni le possette parti Sancti Benedicti*" was shown to them.

On Monday, after the meeting lasted about 4 hours, and which concerned the organization of the teaching to be carried out at the University of Cassino in the period September 30 – October 9 2021, the group of participants continued the visit to the Benedictine Abbey of Montecassino until 5.00 pm. Finally, a visit to the medieval village of San Pietro was organized. The village was completely razed to the ground then by fifteen days of Allied bombing, another hundreds of deaths. During the bombing of the battle in December 1943 many Sanpietresi took refuge in what were called "caves of the valley", some took refuge on Mount Sambucaro. The images of those dark moments were portrayed in John Huston's documentary The Battle of St Peter. In the stretch of the Gustav Line which included San Pietro Infine and Mignano Monte Lungo for the first time, the Italian soldiers fought alongside the allies. today it is a ghost town that still remembers, with its

alleys and destroyed houses, the horrors of war. The Group have also visited the multimedia Museum of San Pietro Infine, conceived by Officine Rambaldi.

At the end of the day a visit to a farm was organized for the tasting of local products, in particular cheeses and wines.

On Tuesday morning a visit was organized to the archaeological area of Cassino, the ancient *Casisum*, which still retains, the theater, the amphitheater (I BC - I AD) and the Tomb of Ummidia Quadratilla from the II-I century BC. Moreover, the group of participants also visited the interesting National Archaeological Museum "G. Caretoni". The museum exhibits finds from the city and its immediate surroundings, dating back to pre-Roman times, enriched by a choice of materials relating to the Volsci civilization of ancient Satricum (locality Le Ferriere, Latina) and recent findings in the Roman necropolis on the Pedemontana. West of the city (octagonal room). In the other rooms there are the materials of the Roman Casinum, including valuable theatrical works (cast of the statue in heroic nudity of the so-called Hero of Cassino, the original of which is kept in the National Archaeological Museum of Naples; fragments of a colossal statue of Augustus; architectural elements of decoration of the scaenae frons of the theater), to which is added a remarkable funerary bed in bone found during recent excavations in the western necropolis of nearby Aquinum.
